This documentation outlines the comprehensive framework, responsibilities, and procedures established by the Anti-Ragging Committee to effectively combat and eradicate ragging activities.

Vision

The vision of the Anti-Ragging Committee is to foster a campus environment that upholds dignity, respect, and inclusivity for all students. It aims to eliminate ragging in all its forms, ensuring that

every student feels safe, valued, and empowered to excel academically and socially without fear of harassment or intimidation.

Objectives

Prevention: The committee is committed to preventing ragging through proactive measures such as awareness campaigns, orientation programs, and strict enforcement of anti-ragging policies.

<u>Education and Awareness</u>: Conducting regular workshops, seminars, and awareness sessions to educate students, faculty, and staff about the detrimental effects of ragging and the importance of maintaining a ragging-free environment.

<u>Support and Assistance:</u> Providing immediate support and assistance to victims of ragging incidents, including counseling, medical aid, and legal guidance.

<u>Policy Implementation:</u> Ensuring the effective implementation and enforcement of antiragging policies and guidelines in compliance with statutory provisions.

<u>Investigation and Action</u>: Promptly investigating reported incidents of ragging in a fair and impartial manner, taking necessary disciplinary actions against the perpetrators, and ensuring justice for the victims.

Monitoring and Evaluation: Continuously monitoring the campus environment to identify and address potential ragging incidents, evaluating the effectiveness of preventive measures, and making necessary improvements to existing policies.

Duties and Responsibilities

Policy Development: Developing comprehensive anti-ragging policies and guidelines in collaboration with stakeholders, ensuring clarity, inclusivity, and alignment with legal requirements.

<u>Orientation Programs:</u> Organizing orientation programs for new students to raise awareness about the institution's zero-tolerance policy towards ragging and outlining the consequences of engaging in such activities.

Awareness Campaigns: Conducting regular awareness campaigns through posters, leaflets, and digital media to sensitize the entire campus community about the negative impacts of ragging and encouraging bystander intervention.

<u>Support Services</u>: Providing comprehensive support services to victims, including psychological counseling, medical assistance, and legal aid, to help them cope with the trauma and consequences of ragging.

<u>Disciplinary Actions:</u> Recommending appropriate disciplinary actions against individuals or groups found guilty of ragging, ranging from warnings and fines to suspension or expulsion, depending on the severity of the offense.



ANTI-RAGGING AWARENESS PROGRAMS

In India, ragging is a serious issue that has been addressed through various legislative measures and guidelines to prevent its occurrence and provide legal recourse for victims. The primary legislative framework addressing ragging includes:

- 1. University Grants Commission (UGC) Regulations on Curbing the Menace of Ragging: These regulations provide guidelines to all educational institutions under the UGC's purview to prevent ragging. They mandate the formation of Anti-Ragging Committees and Squads, measures for sensitization and awareness among students, and strict penalties for those found guilty of ragging.
- 2. **The Ragging Prohibition Act, 1999**: This act was enacted by the Government of India to prohibit ragging in educational institutions. It defines ragging broadly and prescribes stringent measures against those involved, including imprisonment and fines.
- 3. **Indian Penal Code (IPC)**: While the IPC itself does not have specific provisions dedicated solely to ragging, certain sections can be applied in cases of ragging, depending on the nature and severity of the offense. Key sections that may be invoked include:
 - Section 323 (Punishment for voluntarily causing hurt)
 - Section 324 (Voluntarily causing hurt by dangerous weapons or means)
 - Section 325 (Punishment for voluntarily causing grievous hurt)
 - Section 326 (Voluntarily causing grievous hurt by dangerous weapons or means)
 - Section 354 (Assault or criminal force to woman with intent to outrage her modesty)
 - Section 509 (Word, gesture or act intended to insult the modesty of a woman)

These sections can be applied depending on the specific actions involved in the ragging incident, such as physical assault, mental harassment, or outrage of modesty. The penalties under these sections range from fines to imprisonment, depending on the severity of the offense and harm caused to the victim.

It's important to note that universities and educational institutions are required to follow the UGC guidelines and implement anti-ragging measures effectively. The UGC regulations provide a comprehensive framework for prevention, monitoring, and punishment of ragging incidents within educational institutions across India.
