

CHEMICAL DISASTER PREVENTION DAY ON 5 - 12 – 2022

The Department of Chemistry conducted an awareness programme on the occasion of Chemical Disaster Prevention Day on 4th December 2022 for all science students. Our principal Dr. N. Prasad Babu garu inaugurated this programme and stressed the importance of precautions in chemical industries. Vice principal Sri B.Srivasa Rao garu explained about Bhopal Gas Tragedy in a detailed manner. Sri U. Venkatacharyulu, Head of the Chemistry Department discussed about the incident which took place in Bhopal on 3/12/1984. The poisonous gas, Methyl Isocyanate (MIC) was killed 3000 people and around 2,50,000 people were left permanently disabled. He also said that after that incident, the Ministry of Environment and Forest announced the 4th December as a Chemical Disaster Prevention Day. In this programme Dr.M.Madhu, Lecturer in Chemistry and other Lecturers and students participated in this programme.
