GUEST LECTURE ON SHARES AND DEBENTURES

The Department of Commerce, CSTS Government Kalasala, Jangareddigudem invited a Guest lecturer named Sri G.Ram Mohan Rao, Lecturer in Commerce, Model Degree College, Kamavarapukota, Eluru District on 22.6.2023 at 11:00 to 1:00 P.m.

Shares and debentures are essential components of the financial market, enabling companies to raise capital for their operations and growth. Ram Mohan Rao began the lecture by explaining the basic concepts of shares and debentures. He emphasized that shares represent ownership in a company, granting shareholders voting rights and a share in the company's profits through dividends. On the other hand, debentures are debt instruments through which companies borrow money from the public and promise to repay it with periodic interest payments.

Next, Ram Mohan Rao delved into the various types of shares and debentures. He described common shares and their significance in the equity market, where shareholders participate in the company's fortunes and bear higher risks and rewards. Additionally, he discussed preferred shares, highlighting their preference in receiving dividends and claim over assets during liquidation.

Turning to debentures, Ram Mohan Rao explained the distinctions between convertible and non-convertible debentures. Convertible debentures can be converted into shares at a predetermined ratio, providing an option for investors to participate in equity growth. Non-convertible debentures, on the other hand, remain as debt and do not convert into shares.


To ensure a well-rounded understanding, Ram Mohan Rao also covered the regulatory and legal aspects of shares and debentures. He explained the guidelines set by the Securities and Exchange Board of India (SEBI) to protect investors' interests and maintain market integrity.

Concluding his lecture, he summarized the key points and underscored the significance of shares and debentures in the financial market. He urged the students to continue exploring the subject, emphasizing that a thorough understanding of these financial instruments would be invaluable for making informed investment decisions and navigating the dynamic world of finance.

In essence, Ram Mohan Rao's guest lecture was a resounding success, equipping the students with a solid foundation in shares and debentures and igniting their interest in the exciting realm of financial markets.

Dr. N. Prasad Babu, Principal of this college conclusion marks and remarked that Commerce is one of the most significant courses in the UG level. The students, who did the graduation with B.Com, have bright future and better prospects of employment. He also expressed that the Commerce subject has greater importance in higher education. The in charge of the department, Dr. K.Uttamsagar detailed the benefits and drawbacks of both shares and debentures. He discussed how shares offer the potential for capital appreciation and ownership in the company's success but carry the risk of capital loss if the company's performance falters. Debentures, on the other hand, provide a fixed income stream through interest payments, but investors do not benefit from the company's growth.
